Rowden replied that it only leaves one access to the other side of town. Lindsey said that they close that section due to parking on the other side of Stewart. Councilmember Garza said it was set up the same way for the wine festival. Rowden said that she hadn't seen the closure before except for the last two events in Railroad Park. Lindsey said that they have been doing that with the car show because of the number of cars.

Hadfield stated that it is a quote. Mayor Laws said that the quotes came in at close to \$50,000 and GNS was able to get it down. Councilmember Irvin said that he is glad to see that we are shopping locally. Vice Mayor Rowden said that she sees it is nine ductless split systems, but it doesn't give the tonnage and do we know what the sear rating is. Hadfield replied that she does not know the sear rating. Jeff Stoddard worked with GNS to make sure the quotes were comparable in systems. Councilmember Lindsey said that he assumes it is a Mitsubishi system but he would like to have seen an American Standard. Councilmember Bowlby said that GNS uses Mitsubishi or Greer on their split ductless systems. Councilmember Johnson asked why we waited so long. Hadfield replied that we had to get the quotes in. Lindsey asked if the GNS invoice included tax to which Vice Mayor Rowden said that it says total price. Rowden asked about the labor and electrical that needs to be done to install the system. Hadfield replied that Jeff Stoddard will be building the platforms for the second story and Pacheco will do the electrical which is minimal. Lindsey also noticed the warranty on GNS is ten years where others are five. Johnson said we are saving money because we are shopping locally.
