4. **DECLARATION ON CONFLICT OF INTEREST**-There was no response from the Mayor, Council members or staff.
5. **ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA**-It was moved and seconded to adopt the agenda as presented. **CARRIED.**
6. **DISCUSSION REGARDING BUDGET INCOME ON BONDS IN VARIOUS FUNDS, LEASE PAYMENTS AND THE OPERATION OF THE MAGISTRATE COURT BY COCHISE COUNTY.**
City Manager Pat McCourt stated Finance Director Ruth Graham will report on this section of the budget process. Ms. Graham reported the work session is to look at fixed payments. A handout was presented with the scheduled current in **bold** and based by Fund. Explanation was given on each fund and responded to the Mayor and Council's questions and/or concerns.

Questions addressed in the Sewer Fund were that these are secured by rate users paid. The City must operate to get sufficient revenue to pay. Councilman Norris asked how many years is remaining to pay the water and sewer and Ms. Graham replied Sewer 2025 and Water 2036. The City Manager reminded the Mayor and Council we are looking at large

expenditures on the Waste Water Treatment Plant (WWTP) and we will pursue grant funding. More than likely we will have to incur indebtedness for repairs necessary in the WWTP.

Staff will be meeting with Cochise County on Wednesday on the Magistrate Court Consolidation contract. Our costs will be based on portion of Court work and not on the exact positions.

Councilman Johnson stated his comment is he would have liked to have had this handout over the weekend or prior to today to have time for review and probably would have had more questions.
