- **AYSO** – Jeff Stoddard presented and stated that a green practice field is needed with lights.
- **Little League/Girls Softball** – Jennifer Wilson presented and shared that they do not need new fields, only better maintenance on current fields. It's difficult with multiple kids to go between Quail and Keiller Park for practice. LED lighting would help reduce the costs for lights.
