

RESOLUTION NO: 2010-90

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLCOX, COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA, RATIFYING, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE APPLICATION TO THE UNION PACIFIC FOUNDATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPLYING FOR \$5,000.00 TO BE USED FOR THE RELOCATION OF THE HISTORIC MASCOT & WESTERN PASSENGER CAR TO RAILROAD PARK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST.

WHEREAS, the CITY is empowered pursuant to A.R.S. § 9-240 (A) and (B) to control the finances and property of the corporation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Willcox Mayor and Council desire to ratify the submittal of an application to the **Union Pacific Foundation** for grant funds to relocate the Historic Mascot & Western passenger car together with the railway signal light and a railway phone booth to Railroad Park; and

WHEREAS, CITY staff seek Mayor and Council ratification and approval for the submitted application to the Union Pacific Foundation; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Willcox have determined that it is in the best interest of the City and its citizens to ratify and approve the submitted application to the Union Pacific Foundation for funds in the amount of \$5,000; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council is dedicated to restoring and maintaining the history of our historic community; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to have this item presented at its August 16, 2010 Council Meeting; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Willcox, Cochise County, Arizona, that an emergency be declared to exist to assure approval and ratification of the submitted application, and that this Resolution be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Willcox, Cochise County, Arizona, that the City hereby formally ratifies and approves the submitted application to the Union Pacific Foundation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council that, due to an existing emergency declared herein, the immediate effectiveness of this Resolution is necessary to preserve the peace, health, and safety of the City of Willcox, Cochise County, Arizona, and this Resolution shall therefore be effective upon its passage and adoption.
