

**CITY OF WILLCOX, COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA**

**RESOLUTION 2013-27**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLCOX, COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA, (“CITY”) APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF 77 TONS OF CRS-2 OIL AND APPLICATOR TRUCK AND DRIVER FROM WESTERN EMULSIONS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THIS RESOLUTION AND DIRECTING AUTHORIZED CITY OFFICERS AND AGENTS TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES AND INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST.**

**WHEREAS**, the CITY is empowered pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes, Title 9, Section 9-240(A) to have control of the finances and property of the corporation and authorized pursuant to A.R.S. §9-240(B)(3) to maintain and improve City streets; and,

**WHEREAS**, CITY staff requested bids for the provision of seventy seven (77) tons of CRS-2 oil, applicator truck and driver to provide services and mobilization for a thirteen (13) block chip seal in CITY and Western Emulsions responded with the lowest quote of \$43,245.74; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council have determined that formal action on this Resolution is in the best interest of the CITY and its citizens; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the preservation of peace, health, and the safety of the City of Willcox, Cochise County, State of Arizona, that an emergency be declared to exist and directing that this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLCOX, ARIZONA**, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize and approve the purchase of seventy seven (77) tons of CRS-2 oil and the provision of services of an applicator truck and driver from Western Emulsions responded with the lowest quote of \$43,245.74; and,

**SECTION 2:** CITY Officials and Administrators are authorized and directed to take all action required to fulfill the purposes of this Resolution; and,

**SECTION 3:** That the Mayor is authorized and empowered to execute the Resolution as presented; and,

**SECTION 4:** That the immediate operation of the provisions of this Resolution is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City of Willcox, Cochise County, Arizona.
